



DURACK SCHOOL

ENROLMENT POLICY

Palmerston City Schools work under a priority enrolment system which means that we accept enrolments from families in the priority areas of Durack, Pinelands, Yarrowonga and Robbie Robbins Reserve.

DURACK SCHOOL AND PRESCHOOL ENROLMENT ELIGIBILITY

Children who reside in Durack, Yarrowonga, Pinelands and Robbie Robbins Reserve or the child has a sibling already attending Durack School are eligible to enrol.

Students who reside in other suburbs in Palmerston are expected to enrol in their local school and will not be considered for enrolment unless there are proven extenuating circumstances. An interview with the Principal or Assistant Principal is required before your child commences school.

PRESCHOOL

- Children turning 4 on or before the 30th of June are eligible to commence Preschool at the beginning of that year.
 - Children turning four after 30 June of that year are eligible to enrol after their birthday if places are available and with the understanding that the child will access more than 12 months of Preschool.

- Durack Preschool has the capacity to cater for the enrolment.

Parents may put their child's name on a waiting list for enrolment however when a position becomes available priority will be given to the eldest student on the list provided all other criteria for enrolment are met.

An offer of a position at Durack Preschool for children who reside outside of Durack School Priority enrolment area does not guarantee a placement in a Transition class at Durack School.

TRANSITION

Children who turn 5 by 30th June are eligible to enrol in Transition at the commencement of the school year. Children who turn 5 after 30th June are not eligible to enrol in a Transition class until the following year.

Parents or Guardians can obtain the appropriate forms for enrolment from the school office. Immunisation records, proof of date of birth and proof of residency are required when enrolling.
